The Regular Meeting of the Borough Council of Washington, Warren County, New Jersey was held in the Council Chambers of Borough Hall at 7:00 P.M.

COUNCIL APPEARANCE:

Rolling Thunder Inc. NJ Chapter 3

Diane Molenga, Chapter Secretary of Rolling Thunder Inc. NJ Chapter 3

Ms. Molenga informed Council that the Rolling Thunder organization has a new program. In this program, they would like to honor hometown heroes who have been killed in action or held prisoner of war. Ms. Molenga submitted a letter to council, which requests to honor fallen soldiers and prisoners of war with a campaign on name streets where they were raised, established residence or went to school. Ms. Molenga, on behalf of the Rolling Thunder Inc. NJ Chapter 3 asked for permission from council to locate soldiers within the Borough of Washington and name the streets in their honor. Ms. Molenga explained that the Rolling Thunder Inc. NJ Chapter 3 would create the street signs at no cost to the Borough. Ms. Molenga explained that the street sign would either be above the street name, or as a freestanding pole. Ms. Molenga explained that these signs do not change the 911 systems at all because they are honorary street signs. Ms. Molenga explained that a Borough resolution would have to be passed for the naming of the streets. Ms. Molenga further explained that the signs are Department of Transportation approved, and are reflective and eight millimeters thick. She then provided council with a sample sign and a packet of the information she discussed.

Council Discussion:

Councilman Torres stated he believed it was a wonderful idea, and asked if there was a list assembled of the servicemen and women that would be receiving this honor. Ms. Molenga responded that she has a list of soldiers. She then explained that there was a ceremony for the naming of the street.

Councilwoman Conry asked who determined which streets were named. Ms. Molenga explained that the families of the soldiers chose.

Council asked several questions regarding the logistics of process. Ms. Molenga explained that if two soldiers were named for one road, there could be two different street signs.

A motion was made by Jones, seconded by Gleba to approve the honorary street signs.

Andrew Ward, Parks and Recreation Director

Mr. Ward gave a brief introduction of himself and discussed his past experience. He stated he is excited to work with Washington Borough as the new Parks and Recreation Director.

Hometown Heroes - Luke Gleba

Mr. Gleba explained his proposal for hometown heroes. He provided Council with a packet of information. Mr. Gleba explained that Hometown Heroes would be a way to show the Borough's gratitude for the sacrifices made by current members of the military. Mr. Gleba explained that the Borough could designate wall space in Borough Hall to place pictures of current service members.

A motion was made by Higgins, seconded by Jones to designate wall space in Borough Hall.

Green Energy and Energy in the Bank (Financial Bakers for Washington Community Solar)

Mr. DePhillipo of Green Energy Partners (GRP) provided Council of an amendment the Power Purchase Agreement that GRP is proposing. Mr. DePhillipo provided council with an

information packet that explains the history of GRP. Mr. DePhillipo explained this is on the same property and location and the land approvals have been granted. The biggest issue, he explained, is the size of the system. The new layout is 600 kw and is smaller, due to the fact that the delivery of output was over promised. Mr. DePhillipo explained that the size of the system output has changed.

Council questioned that in the amendment, it said GRP would have nine months to finish their permits. Councilman Torres noted that Mr. DePhillipo previously stated that GRP had half of their permits completed. Council explained that this project has been in the works for two years, and this project could be expedited. Mr. DePhillipo explained that GRP has land use permits, not building permits. He would need to apply for building permits and for construction vehicles, which he estimates would take a combined six months. He also stated weather concerns. He explained that actual construction period is not a long period of time.

Mr. DePhillipo discussed the energy savings the Borough could expect to see, which were outlined in the information packet he provided council.

Councilwoman Gleba explained that she was not in favor of deleting section B from the amendment. Mr. DePhillipo explained he would have to go back and discuss this with his bank to make sure the project is able to be financed with that section remaining in the agreement.

Mr. DePhillipo further clarified information that he provided for Council within the packet of information. Council then voiced their concerns regarding the circumstances of the project at length. They explained that they would like the project to be finished as soon as possible. Council then asked if Washington Township giving power to the Borough would give the Borough Sustainable New Jersey credits. Mr. DePhillipo stated that he would look into that for the Borough.

A motion was made by Torres, seconded by Conry to extend the amendment

Business Improvement District- Pocket Park

Council stated that the Agreement would need to be in an ordinance.

Council discussed several points in the agreement, including costs to rent the space and revenue. The BID explained that the park was public space so there would not be a cost to rent the area.

The BID explains that the Borough owns the park. Council voiced their concern that the BID has majority control over the park. The BID explained that their intent was to make sure those who wanted to use the park would need to contact the BID to insure the park is well maintained.

Council discussed that they would like to also have control over the park as well. The BID explained that they are trying to protect their interests in this matter. Council asked who would take care of the maintenance of the park. The BID explained that the maintenance of the park would be the Boroughs responsibility.

Council stated that if it is the Boroughs responsibility to maintain the park, they should have full responsibility and control of the park.

Council then discussed at length the matter of the BID collecting revenue from usage of the park. The BID explained that the revenues collected would be from fundraisers for the BID.

Council then discussed the matter naming the park. Council used the example of persons or companies making contributions to the park, and that affecting the naming of the park. Council agreed that the naming of the park should be the responsibility of the Borough.

The BID stated that if they cede all control to the Borough, how they would insure that the BID will have use of the park during all of the times they wish to use the park.

The BID explained that they could give the Borough a modified calendar of all the events they anticipate having at the park.

Council agreed to change the document into the form of an ordinance.

around the Borough. The Code Enforcement officer explained that 33 State Street had not been summoned. Manager Blanchard suggested reaching out to Bank of America, as they have a property maintenance team. Council suggested having the Borough D.P.W. trim the grass in the interest of public safety. Manager Blanchard explained that if it were an unsafe situation, she would not request the D.P.W. to enter the property and attempt to maintain it. Council suggested contacting Animal Control. Manager Blanchard informed Ms. Spinks that she would reach out to Bank of America.

Councilwoman Gleba asked Manager Blanchard to send an email blast and change the website to cancel the upcoming Senior meeting next week. Councilwoman Gleba added that she will not be able to attend the next Council meeting. Councilwoman Gleba asked Manager Blanchard to inform the BID that Paramount may be interested in selling their property.

Mayor McDonald added that the possibility of Paramount selling is still up in the air. Mayor McDonald strongly expressed his frustration with Paramount and stated that the Borough needs an abandoned property ordinance. Mayor McDonald urged Council to keep their eyes on the Paramount buildings for any violations.

Councilman Jones asked about the abandoned properties ordinance that was repealed in the past. Mayor McDonald stated that part of the reason that the ordinance was repealed in the past was due to manpower and costs. Mayor McDonald added that if Council wishes to have the abandoned properties ordinance in effect again that money needs to be budgeted to enforce the ordinance. Councilman Jones also added that there has to be a way to get the lawns mowed on the abandoned properties in town. Manager Blanchard asked Code Enforcement Officer Bescherer to identify the properties as to which are owned by banks and which are owned by tax services. Manager Blanchard stated that she can start going after the banks on that list to get them to clean up the properties.

Mayor McDonald stated that the Borough may have a solution for Mt. Pisgah Ame Church. Mayor McDonald and Manager Blanchard met with the engineer, members of Mt. Pisgah, and a representative from JCP&L. JCP&L would put down stone first and then the Borough would use millings to pave the JCP&L driveway and at the end of North Lincoln there would be a lip in order to channel the water into the woods. This should alleviate the runoff that the church parking lot is getting. Mayor McDonald added that there is nothing finalized with this but everyone was in agreement.

Council Discussion:

Manager Blanchard stated that several years ago the State of New Jersey mandated that all of the D.P.W. vehicles be retro fitted with exhaust systems that meet state standards. It was state mandated but paid for by the state. Their was a grant program at the time and the Borough finally has all of the D.P.W. trucks fitted with the proper exhaust which was all paid by the State of New Jersey. Any municipality that did not comply with the mandate will have to pay for the exhausts themselves. Councilwoman Gleba also noted thank to Kurt Klausfelder for the Emergency Management Report.

OLD BUSINESS:

Councilman Higgins noted that the Streets Committee met and the committee put together a list of the costs by street for the seven streets in town that are priority to be paved. Due to the costs of paving, the Streets Committee is recommending to pave North Lincoln which will be mostly funded through the D.O.T. grant that was received. Also, the Streets Committee recommended paving Youmans Avenue East, Taylor Street and Green Street. Councilman Higgins added that is all that can be done with the amount that was budgeted. The approximate cost of Taylor Street is \$20,000, Green Street is \$21,000, Youmans Avenue is \$40,000 and the cost of North Lincoln above the grant amount is \$20,000. The other streets recommended but not in the budget for this year are Warren Street, Davis Avenue, Presidential Drive and Flower Avenue. Councilwoman Gleba asked if the Streets Committee can prepare a plan so that the streets that have been requested for paving are not forgotten. Councilman Higgins added that the Streets Committee already has the costs for the other streets recommended such as Flower Avenue which is \$80,000. The costs may go up by next year. Presidential Drive is \$46,000, Davis Avenue is \$7,000, and Warren Street is \$8,000. Councilwoman Gleba added that in the meantime there needs to be a maintenance plan in place to maintain these other roads that are falling apart. Councilman Jones added that he has another plan that he will bring up later in the meeting during Council remarks.

RECAP:

Manager Blanchard noted that all of Council should have received a copy of the Annual Audit. Manager Blanchard added that CFO Turchan will be in attendance at the next Council Meeting and Council also requested that the Auditor, Mr. Tom Ferry attend as well. Manager Blanchard also stated that the tax bills will be mailed out next week to the residents. Manager Blanchard commented to Councilwoman Gleba that she is working on the budget chart that they discussed and will forward her the draft. Manager Blanchard also met with the E.P.A. this week regarding the Superfund Site which will be a building on the property of the Park Avenue Apartments for the water filtering system. The E.P.A. will be in attendance at the second Council Meeting in September to provide an overview and an update.

COUNCIL REMARKS:

Councilman Jones commented that since the streets are in such poor condition, would Council consider doing a bond to get the work done putting a question on the ballot. leaving it up to the taxpayers. Councilman Jones stated that Council would need to get a more up to date estimate including all the streets in the Borough that are in poor condition to come up with a total dollar figure for the bond. Manager Blanchard added that this would need to be done by September to go on the ballot and the bond ordinance would have to come before the governing body to be voted on. Councilman Torres doesn't feel going out for bond at this time would be a good idea. Councilman Jones added that's why it should be on the ballot and up to the taxpayers. Mayor McDonald noted that in 2016 the Borough should see a significant reduction in current bond payments so that may be a more suitable time to enter into another bond. Mayor McDonald suggested that the Streets Committee discuss this further and come up with a plan. Councilman Jones commented about the statute that was recently passed which would aid the Borough with title searches and finding out who owns the abandoned homes that are in foreclosure. Manager Blanchard added that this will give the Borough the opportunity to find the bank and get them to take responsibility for maintaining the property. Attorney Parikh noted that she will get a copy of the statute and forward to Manager Blanchard. Attorney Parikh also added that it gives the municipality the ability to penalize the bank as if it was any other homeowner. Councilman Jones also asked for an update on the Pleasant Valley Mill Dam. Manager Blanchard replied that she spoke with CFO Turchan and if Council wishes to continue with decommissioning the dam, sewer funds can be used to do so in next year's budget. Manager Blanchard added that there are maintenance issues that need to be addressed this year. These maintenance issues will take approximately three weeks to complete utilizing a full D.P.W. crew. Manager Blanchard is looking into other avenues such as hiring a contractor to complete the work. Councilman Jones also asked about the status of the time clocks. Manager Blanchard stated that she will have a proposal from the company in the Manager's Report next week.

Councilman Higgins asked if the money was received from Cinelli for the scrap metal that was collected so far. Manager Blanchard replied that unfortunately the gentleman that was in charge of the Borough's account had suddenly passed away and Cinelli is having a hard time figuring out where they went wrong. Councilman Higgins would like for Attorney Parikh to send Cinelli a letter requesting that the money for the scrap metal collected so far be sent immediately. Councilman Higgins noted that there will be a Streets Committee Meeting on July 21st at 10:30 a.m. Councilman Higgins also asked if Mr. Bloom from Finelli Engineering had inspected the parking lot before it was paid for and can Council get a report from that inspection. Manager Blanchard will get a report from Mr. Bloom and provide copies to Council.

Councilman Thompson asked for an update on the title search company in regards to Cattelle Court. Manager Blanchard replied that she received some information from the company today but has not reviewed it yet.

Councilwoman Conry stated that the Recreation Commission said the nets are up but the fire truck was not able to get to the outfield because the ground was too soft. The nets are not all the way up on the Route 31 side yet but the Recreation Commission is working on a solution.

Councilwoman Gleba requested that Manager Blanchard write a letter to New Jersey American Water because they replace piping all along Sunrise Terrace and did an unsatisfactory job. Councilwoman Gleba stated that on a few occasions the work crew began at 4:15 a.m. which is in direct violation with the Borough's Nuisance Ordinance. N.J.A.W. needs to be aware that they should not start work until 7:00 a.m. in the Borough. Councilwoman Gleba also stated that the street is in worse condition now than it was before the project. Councilman Higgins asked if the engineer would have to approve that. Manager Blanchard stated that when a street opening permit is opened, then the engineer has to inspect it. Councilwoman Gleba also commented that the Senior Committee will be getting ready for their second annual "Senior Night Out" later this summer. Lastly, Councilwoman Gleba asked Manager Blanchard for the updates on the street ordinance so the committee can finalize the ordinance and introduce to Council.

Mayor McDonald stated Mr. Dunn from Paramount Properties has not done anything that he has been asked to do. Mr. Dunn sent an email to Mayor McDonald asking for a meeting. Mayor McDonald replied that he is done with meeting with him and needs to see action on the properties. Mayor McDonald encouraged Council to call Mr. Dunn and perhaps that will get things moving.

At this time, Mayor McDonald stated that an Executive Session is needed for the purpose of litigation discussion. A motion made by Jones, seconded by Conry to enter into Executive Session after a ten minute recess.

BOROUGH OF WASHINGTON FUND BALANCE POLICY

WHEREAS, the Borough Council (the "Governing Body") of the Borough of Washington acknowledges the maintenance of fiscal stability is important to the prudent operation of government and in determining its creditworthiness; and

WHEREAS, the ability to adjust local government revenues during the budget year and from year to year may be limited to meet unanticipated expenditures resulting from, inter alia, natural disasters, unforeseen increases in operating costs, unexpected capital expenditures; and

WHEREAS, changes in federal and state government spending policies can also impact local government revenues, particularly if reductions in such spending force local governments to increase their own spending to make up for the loss in federal and state government revenue; and

WHEREAS, fund balance, represents an available resource that can be used to meet working capital requirements, emergency expenditures and afford transition due to systemic changes in revenues and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, sufficient levels of unreserved fund balance can assure the continued orderly operation of government and the provision of services to taxpayers and the stability of the tax structure; and

WHEREAS, local governments frequently utilize a percentage of the municipality's annual operating expenditures as the means of determining the appropriate level of an unreserved fund balance; and

WHEREAS, maintaining the stability of sufficient levels of unreserved fund balance will be equally important for the Borough of Washington, so that the fund balance policy will be meaningful and effective; and

NOW THEREFORE, a fund balance target should be established and the following shall be used as guidelines.

- 1. The Borough of Washington shall establish or maintain a target fund balance of <u>4</u> % to <u>10</u> % of the previous year's operating expenditures (the "Target").
- 2. Amounts appropriated in the ensuing budget which reduce the fund balance below the target balance for the purpose of reducing the ensuing year's property tax levy, may be made only upon a specific vote of the Governing Body.
- 3. Drawdown of the fund balance, without the reasonable expectation of regenerating such amounts drawn down during the budget year, is evidence of a structural imbalance of the Borough of Washington budget. A plan shall be developed to restore fund balance to the Target balance within a three-year period.

4. As part of the annual budget process, amounts in excess of the Target that are used in the budget are considered "non-recurring" revenues and should be allocated/budgeted to, among other things, purchase capital assets with a useful life of 5 years or more, fund other reserves, or provide "one-time" direct tax relief and not to support increased operating expenses.

5. If the year-end available fund balance, based upon unaudited figures, is for any reason below the Target, then, to rebuild the fund balance toward the Target, no more than 40 % of the surplus generated in the prior fiscal year shall be appropriated as a revenue

- in the succeeding year's budget.6. The Governing Body, by vote, can declare a fiscal emergency and withdraw any amount of General Fund balance for purposes of addressing the fiscal emergency. Any such action
- must also provide a plan to restore fund balance to the Target within a five-year period.7. This policy will be reviewed by the Governing Body every three years following adoption or sooner at the direction of the Governing Body.
