ORDINANCE 2023-13

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AS A GENERAL IMPROVEMENT THE LEASE OF THE DPW VEHICLES FROM THE ENTERPRISE SOLUTIONS BOROUGH OF WASHINGTON AND APPROPRIATING \$40,000 THEREFOR FROM THE "CAPITAL FUND BALANCE" OF SAID BOROUGH

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Washington in Warren County,

New Jersey as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Borough of Washington in Warren County (hereinafter referred to as "Municipality") is hereby authorized the following Capital Improvements for the Borough of Washington:

1. The lease of the DPW vehicles

<u>Section 2</u>. The work and acquisitions, authorized by Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be undertaken as

a general improvement, the entire cost of which shall be contributed and borne by the municipality as a general

expense, and no part of said cost shall be specially assessed against any property. The estimated cost noted

of such project shall not exceed \$40,000.00 unless this Ordinance is amended.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that the undertaking of the aforesaid projects (hereinafter

referred to as "purpose") is not a current expense of the municipality; and that the total estimated cost of said

Section 5. The Capital budget of the municipality is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of

this Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.

ORDINANCE 2023-18

Ordinance Amending Chapter 85 of the Code of the Borough of Washington, entitled "Municipal Parking Lots"

WHEREAS, the Borough of Washington Chapter 85 of the Code which provides the regulations governing the use of the municipal parking lots;

WHEREAS, with the increase in the number of electric vehicles the Mayor and Borough Council have determined that having electrical vehicle stations in municipal parking lots will benefit the residents of Washington Borough.

WHEREAS, the Mayor Borough Council desires to amend its ordinances to ensure that those parking stalls in municipal parking lots shall be available to only individuals with electric vehicles.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council desires to further amend its ordinances to provide ticketing and towing for violating the electrical vehicle parking ordinance and;

<u>Section 1.</u> Chapter 85 of the Code of the Borough of Washington, entitled "Municipal Park Lots" shall be amended as follows (deletions noted with strikethrough thus and additions noted in bold italic *thus*):

§85.66

- A. No person shall stop, stand or park any non-electric vehicle in a space designated through signage as an electric vehicle charging station.
- B. No electric vehicle shall park in a space designated, through signage, as an electric vehicle charging station when either (1) the electric vehicle is not electrically charging or (2) is parked in the parking space for more than two (2) hours. For purposes of this subsection, "charging" means an electric vehicle is parked at an electric vehicle charging station and is connected to the charging station equipment.
- C. Vehicles parked in violation of these regulations will be subject to ticketing and/or towing in accordance with §§ <u>85-63</u> and <u>85-64</u> of the Code of the Borough of Washington.

<u>Section 2.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed as to such inconsistencies.

<u>Section 3.</u> If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
