- 2. Splash pad water loss a huge concern. Replacing 375 gallons of water daily. It seems Suburban engineering doesn't care. If this keeps up I will have no choice but to shut down splash pad until fixed. That is community water to replace costing tax payer's money. I'm a tax payer as all of you. Run off is horrible and can't run features spraying water like it should be. Also chlorine feeder is overfeeding reservoir that holds splash pad water. This is a huge concern as it over chlorinates splash pad. Will bring this up to engineer also.
- 3. New umbrellas were ordered for life guards. New signs are installed for running. Passed fire inspection. All is coming along.
- 4. Hope All Star game is still a go.
- 5. Pool seems to be operating well with hired staff. No free food has improved our profit. Working with managers to create some fun nights with some music with pool manager doing the DJ.
