• Sports Program Fees - Dan Almind explained that Borough Manager Matt Hall has set up an administrative shared services agreement with Oxford Township which has opened discussions into combining the Recreation Commission and the Oxford Youth Association (OYA). Dan attended an OYA meeting and gathered information. He explained how the OYA is set up and how commissioners would possibly be incorporated. If a new group is formed it will have a new name. Dan invited the OYA Board members to the January 8, 2020 Recreation Commission meeting to discuss a possible merger and will invite the Borough Manager. Discussion of Sports Program Fees will take place during the Jan 22, 2020 meeting.
