1. Regular garbage will be collected in all areas on Fridays. Trash pickup is limited to two (2) thirty-two (32) gallon containers per week, which must be placed curbside either after **6:00 p.m. Thursday evening** or prior to **7:00 a.m. Friday morning** (prior to **6:00 a.m. Friday morning** for Route 57/East and West Washington Avenue). Stickers for extra trash are available from the Information Desk at a cost of two dollars (\$2.00) each. One (1) sticker per extra thirty-two (32) gallon container.
2. Vegetative waste collection begins **Tuesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> 2019**, continuing every Tuesday thereafter ending on **Tuesday, December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019**. All yard trimmings or vegetative waste and/or leaves must be placed in Kraft-type, biodegradable vegetative waste bags or in covered thirty-two (32) gallon capacity heavy-duty plastic or galvanized reusable containers. Do not place any branches, dirt, rocks or garbage in containers with leaves or vegetative waste. **DO NOT PLACE ANY LEAVES IN THE STREET.**
3. Chipping of branches and brush takes place annually. Place branches curbside on dates indicated by "C" on the calendar. The Department of Public Works will begin brush collection after the last brush placement day marked on the calendar. Place branches no larger than four inches (4") in diameter with butt ends facing out toward the curb. **BRANCHES OR BRUSH PLACED CURBSIDE OUTSIDE OF THE DATES INDICATED ON THE CALENDAR WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.**
4. Place Christmas Trees curbside on dates indicated by "T" on the calendar. The Department of Public Works will begin Christmas Tree collection after the last Christmas Tree placement day marked on the calendar. Place trees with butt ends facing out toward the curb. Please be advised that inclement weather may affect Christmas Tree pickup. Sign up for Nixle Alerts, monitor the Borough Social Media Page, and check the website for updates and details.
5. Bulk garbage is collected twice annually – For 2019: **Friday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019** and **Friday, September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019**. **BULK PICKUP REQUIRES A STICKER (OBTAINED FROM BOROUGH HALL) FOR EVERY FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS (500LBS) OF MATERIAL.** Each household is entitled to one (1) sticker free of charge with proof of residency. Additional stickers may be purchased at a cost of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) each-one (1) sticker per additional five hundred pounds (500lbs).
